



How the semester reports work at Eurecole

A booklet is given to the pupils and their parents after the All Saints' Day holiday. It does not include any notes but general assessments on the beginning of the year.

Then, during the year, two semestrials reports cards show the progress of the students.

Those reports are a pedagogical and communicative tool.

Periodic evaluations and quarterly checks provide information on students' disciplinary, methodological and behavioral achievements.

As a link between teachers and parents, the newsletter allows parents to have detailed information about their child's know-how and the progress of their learning.

Maternal Classes

Not all skill sets are required for each period.

Different factors (timing, progression, class level in the cycle) lead to different responses.

Primary Classes

Each newsletter is given to students at the end of the period.

It must be signed by the parents and reported to the school so that the teacher may ensure that there are signatures.

The report card is then givent to the parents indefinitely.
